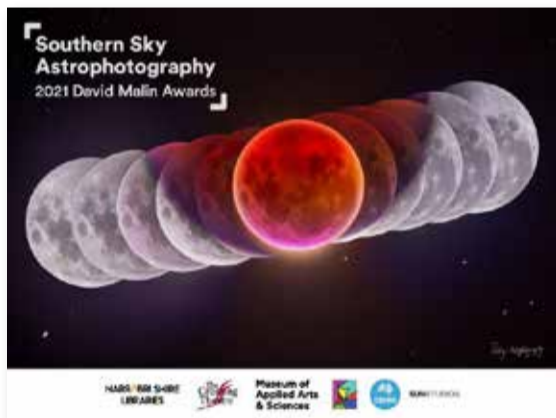

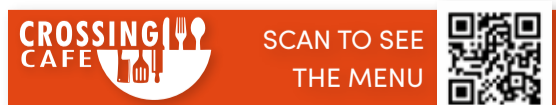


ASTROPHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBITION ON DISPLAY

DRAFT COMMUNITY EVENTS POLICY

Narrabri Shire Council advises that the Draft Community Event Policy endorsed by Council at the May Ordinary Council meeting is now on public exhibition and can be viewed online and at the Shire Libraries at Wee Waa, Narrabri and Boggabri. Feedback can be received via submission prior to adoption.

The objective of this policy is to:

- Clarify Council's support of Community Events held on Council-managed land
- Clarify the procedure for community groups or individuals to apply to host an event
- Set a framework for events managed and supported by Council
- Effectively manage risks inherent to events and to ensure financial and service delivery obligations are fulfilled

It is the intent of Narrabri Shire Council to coordinate and support high quality community events that celebrate diversity, showcase creativity, and recognise sporting achievements.

CHANGES TO BUSINESS AND INDUSTRIAL ZONES

The Department of Planning and Environment is currently exhibiting the transition of existing Business and Industrial Zones into new Employment Zones. This is the implementation stage of a reform within Local Environmental Plans (LEPs) across NSW. Implementation follows introduction of the Employment Zones within the Standard Instrument (Local Environmental Plans) Order 2006 in December 2021.

The department has worked closely with each council to ensure LEPs are amended, consistent with the intent of the reform, while also ensuring the land-use planning outcomes are locally appropriate. After the exhibition, the department will work with councils to finalise implementation ahead of the new zones coming into force on 1 December 2022.
